ABOUT THE ADULT SERVICES PROGRAM

The **Adult Services Program** offers educational and recreational activities and life skills training for Butler County adults with disabilities. Participants learn and reinforce the skills that will enable them to

live independently, according to their capabilities. Math skills and nutrition are learned as they measure ingredients to make easy and tasty meals. A trip to the grocery store teaches participants how to write a shopping list, money management, making change and social interaction.

All participants in the **Adult Services Program** have the opportunity to choose the activities which best suit their interests, talents and capabilities. With our trained staff to assist them, participants learn and practice the valuable skills they need to maintain a more independent and enriching lifestyle.



While enjoying activities such as bowling and sporting events the participants not only improve coordination and get exercise, but learn to work independently and as a team to accomplish a goal. Participants also attend community activities such as picnics, plays, movies, dances and cultural events. Those who participate learn proper social etiquette while they are being entertained. Through these social interactions the importance of personal space and personal safety is reinforced as well.
