### The Children's Services

**Program** offers structured recreational activities throughout the school year for children with disabilities. Through interactive play and adaptive sports, children improve gross and fine motor skills. Creative learning experiences through music, arts and crafts, nature and community discovery reinforce everyday life skills. Math, language, personal safety and relating to peers are fun to learn through games, cooking and other hands-on activities. Children also learn to work as a team and individually to reach their goals.

Although program services are free, participants pay for all admission costs, bowling charges & cost of special events.

Locations and times vary.
