ABOUT THE HOMEMAKER CHORE PROGRAM

The **Homemaker Chore Program** has been serving adults with disabilities throughout Butler County for over 15 years. As a *local community agency*, we are able to provide a quick response to your inquiries for service.

The **Homemaker Chore Program** helps adults with disabilities to remain in their own home by providing assistance with light housekeeping chores. Following a short assessment, our support coordinator will design a service plan based on your individual needs.

Trained homemakers can assist you with everyday tasks including sweeping, vacuuming, dusting, meal preparation and personal laundry. These services can often make the difference between living independently in one's own home or having to move to a long-term care facility.

Referrals for the **CCC Homemaker Chore Program** will be accepted from social service agencies, medical sources, the individuals themselves or concerned community members. A formal evaluation will be completed to determine eligibility for Homemaker Chore services.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THESE SERVICES PARTICIPANTS MUST BE:

- A resident of Butler County
- Between the ages of 18-59
- Intellectually or physically disabled, which will determine their need for Homemaker Chore services.
- Economically disadvantaged, with a monthly family gross income below 250% of federal poverty income guidelines.
